15. SUMMARY:

(C) This report contains information obtained from enemy documents captured on 14 April 1970, and concerns an after-action report, dated 28 February 1970, prepared by an unidentified person ((possibly of a sapper unit of Sub-Region 6)), which describes the sabotage action conducted by five sappers, including one platoon cadre, on the US quarters next to the Rex Cinema on 30 January 1970. The report also pertains to ten military-objective reports, including two sketches, two dated 29 December 1969 and originated by B2/A5 ((possibly a military intelligence element of Sapper Section, Military Region 6)), and the rest undated and originated by unspecified persons, which describe or depict the defensive networks and routine activities in various ((FWMAF/RVNAF)) military compounds in Saigon.

(C) CDEC COMMENT: These documents were captured on 14 April 1970 in South Vietnam (Tay Ninh Province; III CTZ) by 5th Inf Div, RVNAF III CTZ. The documents were received at CDEC on 22 April 1970, and were summarized in Bulletin Number 32,257, dated 22 April 1970, under Items 2 and 4 thru 15 of CDEC Document Log Number 04-2516-70. Translation was requested by JUSPAO, Vietnam.
